



Stand Together - Ranelagh Remembers The Holocaust

Six Year 6 pupils had the honour of representing Ranelagh at the annual Holocaust Memorial event in Stratford Town Hall on Monday. The event marked 75 years since the liberation of the Auschwitz-Birkenau concentration camp and 25 years since the Bosnian genocide. The children were fortunate to hear from survivors of both of these events as they gave powerful recounts of their experiences and spoke of the importance of standing together against prejudice and hate of any kind.

Children across year 6 also contributed their amazingly poignant artwork to an exhibition at the event. Their artwork was inspired by learning about the items that people had taken away from them as they entered concentration camps and focussed on the theme of 'Stand Together'.

Mohammed 6T5 said of the trip. "It was a brilliant experience and we were very lucky to hear from real holocaust survivors. It is important that we learn and talk about these because we will be responsible for making sure nothing like it ever happens again."
