Communication, Language and Literacy

Your child will learn to retell stories and use role play to act out the story. They will learn letter sounds in phonics and learn how to write the sounds. They will use the sounds to help read and write words. You have been provided with the words we will be focusing on so please use these to support your child further.

How you can help your child

- Have a sound hunt.
- Encourage your child to recognise sounds/letters and words around them in signs and food packaging
- Ask your child to write simple shopping lists/ birthday cards/ party invitations.

This may look like random sounds and marks at this point of their learning which is great!

- Practise reading and writing their name.

Maths

Your child will learn to count out objects and toys. They will learn to read and write their numbers. They will put numbers to 10 in order.

How you can help your child

- Regular counting opportunities e.g counting toys and food items by pointing at each item as they count.
- Order toys from biggest to smallest, tallest to shortest, heaviest to lightest.
- Have a shape hunt. Find 2D shapes like squares in windows and 3D shapes like cuboids for cereal boxes.
- Practise reading and writing their numbers (number formation).
- Compare numbers- which number is the largest/smallest?

Understanding the World

How you can help your child

- Talk about people who help us e.g teachers, police, doctors etc.
- Walk to the park and ask your child questions about what they can see around them.
- Talk about what is similar or different in people e.h height, hair colour, eye colour
- Visit the farm- talk about the different types of animals that live there, what do they eat etc
- Look at and identify different places on a map.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

- Ask your child to identify how they were kind or helpful.
- Ask them why they received reward stickers
- Talk about what makes them special

Physical Development

- They will strengthen their motor skills by learning how to use knives and forks, holding pencils and learning to develop their fundamental skills; balance, movement and use of space.
- Please encourage your child to dress and undress themselves independently.

- We will be working on supporting children’s emotional well-being through small group sessions using stories to help children learn how to best manage their feelings and emotions. Children will learn how to express themselves creatively through art, junk-box modelling, role-play and music. Your child may get messy/wet throughout the day so please do provide extra clothing in a bag.
- If you have any questions about your child’s development or how you can further help them at home, please feel free to speak to us at any time.
- We are looking forward to working with you throughout the year to help your child reach their full potential.
