# Curriculum News Spring Term 2022 Year 1

## Homework

Homework is uploaded on Google classroom every **Tuesday**. Please support your child with completing their homework throughout the week and bring their reading books in every **Tuesday**. Please encourage your child to read for at least 15 minutes every day.

If you require a homework book to keep at home please speak to the class teacher.

## General Information

## English

In English children will continue to use their knowledge of letter sounds (phonics) to help them read, write and spell. They will be retelling short stories like '**The Tiger Child**' and '**Whatever Next**' using role-play and will use these stories to help write their own story.

### How you can support your child's learning

- Share the reading, take turns or see whether your child wants to read or be read to.
- Encourage them to write shopping lists or write a letter to a family member.
- Encourage your child to write sentences independently in order to create a story.

## Maths

This term children will be learning to count on to **add** and count back to **subtract** two digit numbers. They will also learn about the value of each numeral in two digit numbers (ones and tens) up to 50 e.g the number 12 is made up of 1 ten and 2 ones.

### How you can support your child's learning

- Complete 5 a day maths homework.
- Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Set up your own toy shop at home! Give some of your toys price tags. Take turns to be the shopkeeper and customer. Buy an item and find the correct coins needed to pay.

## Science

In science, we will be learning about **Everyday Materials**. We will name different materials and discuss their **properties**. Children will also be **investigating** the suitability of the materials.

### How you can support your child's learning

- Be a materials detective and search around your home for different types of materials.
- Talk about which material a table is made from etc
- Describe and talk about the materials properties e.g is it shiny, hard, bendy etc?
- Observe and talk about changes in the weather and the seasons.

## Computing

This term children will continue to use Google Classroom to complete their learning. They will be using different tools and online programs to design and create an image.

## Ranelagh Curriculum

Children's creativity will be developed through our Ranelagh Curriculum where they will be learning about 'Toys' and 'Brilliant Brits'.

- Sort your toys into groups. You can decide how you sort them, e.g. new and old or wheels and no wheels or which material they are made from.
- Design and build a 3D model of a toy. You can use recyclable materials at home to make your toy.
- Create a poster about a famous Brit. Talk about why they are brilliant and write some facts.
- Find out what happened on November 5th 1605.

Children's emotional wellbeing will be supported by providing them with opportunities to discuss and share their ideas about how to manage their feelings and emotions.
