Homework

Homework will be posted on Google Classroom every Friday and will include spellings, reading, writing, Maths, Ranelagh Curriculum and/or Science and needs to be handed in by Wednesday. A paper copy and homework book will be provided if needed and will need to be handed in by Wednesday.

Please support your child with completing their homework throughout the week. Please encourage your child to read for at least 15 minutes every day.

General Information

How you can support your child's learning in English

- Listen to your child read every day and ask them to share a summary of the story including the 5WS (who, what, when, where and why).
- Encourage children to read poetry using actions and expressions.
- Visit a library and borrow books for free.
- Test your child on their spellings each week and ask them to build a sentence with one or two words from the spelling.
- Encourage your child to write about characters in stories using adjectives.

How you can support your child's learning in Maths

- Complete 5-a-day book activities with your child.
- Test your child on their times tables and practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Ask them to make groups of objects and count them mentally e.g. 2 groups of 10 to find the answer for 2×10 .
- Use maths in everyday life, for example weekly shops. Allow your child to work out the cost of 2 or 3 shopping items.
- Ask your child to measure items around the home using a measuring tape (in centimetres and metres).

How you can support your child's learning in Science.

- Identify a range of materials in your home and talk about the properties of that material? Why is a spoon made out of metal? What material is best for a Winter hat?
- Discuss what animals and humans need to survive e.g. food and water.
- Talk to your child about the importance of a healthy diet and why we need to exercise.
- Create an investigation at home exploring suitable materials for an umbrella.

How you can support your child's learning in Computing

How you can support your child's learning

- In Spring 1, We will learn about different modes of Transport. At home, discuss how people travel around London and the rest of the World.
- Compare different modes of transport and discuss materials they are made from.
- Discuss old and new modes of transport and discuss which transport is important in the world.
- In Spring 2, Year 2 will learn about Monarchs and their influence. Discuss how famous monarchs such as the Queen have influenced Britain?
