How you can support your child's learning in English

- Listen to your child read every day and ask them questions about their books, for example who are the main characters? What happens to them? Why?
- Watch Newsround and talk about what is happening in the world.
- Visit a library and borrow books for free.
- Test your child on their spellings each week and ask them to use the words in sentences.
- Encourage your child to write a diary, or write letters to friends or relatives.

Year 4 children will sit a Times Tables test in June. Your child needs to know all their times tables up to 12x10.

How you can support your child's learning in Maths

- Complete 5-a-day book activities with your child.
- Test your child on their times tables.
- Test your child on their number bonds to 20 for example 13 plus what makes 20?
- Get your child to make amounts of money such as 83p using 8 10ps and 3 1ps.
- Use maths in everyday life, for example weekly shops. Allow your child to add the costs together.

How you can support your child's learning in Science

- Take your child on a walk in the park or garden and talk about what different living things you can see.
- Talk about what happens to the ingredients when you're cooking, eg melting.
- Talk about how to look after your teeth and discuss why they are important for humans and animals.
