Healthy School Streets is coming to Ranelagh Primary

Healthy School Streets aim to make it healthier and safer for pupils to walk, cycle or scoot to school and to create more space for social distancing

From **Monday June 27th, 2022**, Corporation Street & Ranelagh Road will become pedestrian and cycle only zone at school drop-off and pick-up times.

From **Monday June 27th, 2022, Corporation Street** (between Eve Road & Meath Road) and **Ranelagh Road** (between Corporation Street & Chaplin Road) will become a pedestrian and cycle only zone at school drop-off and pick-up times.

This is between 8.15 – 9.15am and 2.45-3.45pm, Monday to Friday during term time only.

Only residents who live on this road and emergency services will be able to drive here during these times. Blue Badge holders who can provide the necessary information can apply for exemption through the healthy school streets email below. Please include the following if an exemption is to be considered;

1. Blue Badge Information
2. Vehicle registration corresponding to the applicant &
3. Proof of direct access requirement (ie letter from the school confirming enrolment, letter from employer located within the restriction zone etc)

With less traffic on roads near schools children will breathe cleaner air, feel more comfortable crossing the road and will be able to enjoy an active and healthy journey to school. The Healthy School Street will also create a safer and more pleasant street environment for residents living near schools.

Please remember that other drivers such as visitors or delivery services will not be able to drive into the Healthy School Street during the times of operation. These restrictions are only in place for a few hours during the school term and we appreciate your support to make our streets safer for children in the area!
