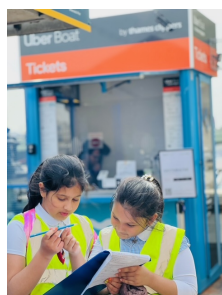


Coronation Breakfast

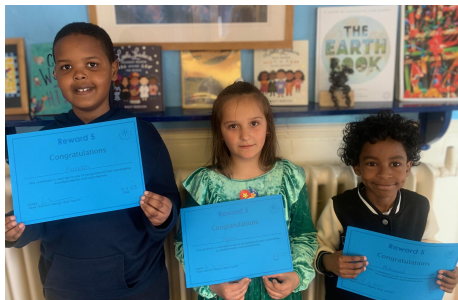
