In 2007, Tania Chowdhury began her career working in Year 1 on a placement. Seeing her talent, she was instantly given a role as a Year 1 teacher. From here, she went into Reception and forged a strong relationship with Mrs Patel. The Inclusion team was formed. Tania became a SENDCo in 2017 and from then our provision for children with additional needs went from strength to strength.

Due to her commitment and passion, and the partnership with Mrs Patel, the practice within the school for children with needs was exceptional, so much so that the Local Authority asked us to create a Resourced Provision specifically for children with Autism. The school is now held in high regard for its inclusive practice. Local Authorities in London have come to see the amazing offer children receive at Ranelagh and authorities in the Netherlands too. The culture of social inclusion is firmly embedded. The story of this remarkable journey is also the story of Mrs Chowdhury's remarkable career and how intrinsic she has been in making 'Ranelagh at the forefront of inclusive practice'. She is now to spread her magnificent wings to be a Deputy Head teacher at a nursery in Newham. Although we are sad to see her go, we cannot wait to see the brilliant innovations that she will bring to her new school. The school has been incredibly lucky to have her.
