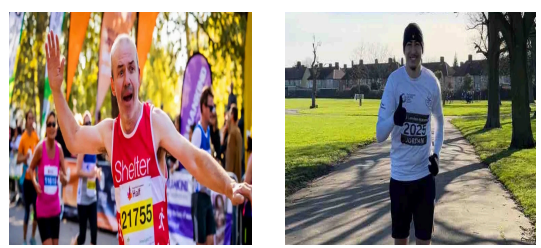


## Welcome Back to the Summer Term.

There is plenty going on over the next term. It is our Geography fieldwork term where the children put their geography skills in to real life practice. EYFS are off to a farm; Year 1 and Year 2 are off to the seaside; Year 3 to Epping Forest; Year 4 to the streets of London and Year 5 are walking up a Creek . All of these educational visits allow your children to experience the real- world beyond the classroom. Of course, the Year groups will continue to go to West Ham Park to develop their Forest School skills which is all part of taking risks. Forest School ‘inspires a deep and meaningful connection to the world and an understanding of how a learner fits within it. The approach to risk means that learners constantly expand on their abilities by solving real-world issues, building self-belief, resilience and mental healthiness’.



Playing also allows these skills to flourish. It is so important for children to play , and to play outside with friends increases their social development. So where you can, ditch the ipad or phone and let your children play.



The culmination of Mr Jordan’s and Mr Murdoch’s training programme ends on Sunday 27th April - as they both run the London Marathon.
