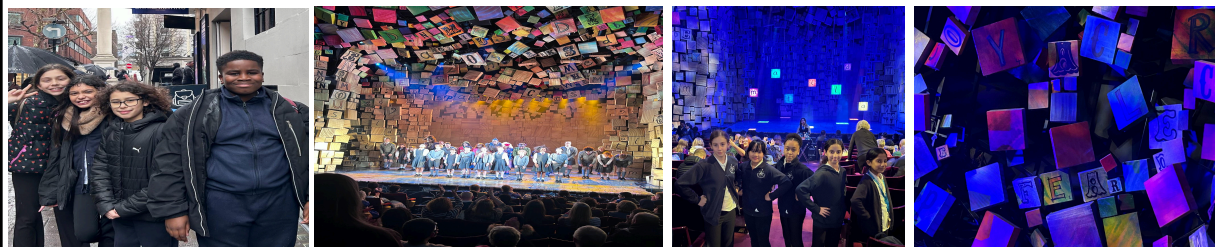


Spring Term Friday 30th January 2026
