Year 4

Homework

Homework will be set every week on **Friday**. Please support your child with completing their homework by **Wednesday** and bring their reading books in every **Friday**.

Your child will bring home a reading book from their class library every **Friday** and this should be returned the following **Friday**. Please encourage your child to read for at least 15 minutes every day.

General Information

Children in 4M2 have PE on Monday and Tuesday.

How you can support your child's learning in English

This term children will explore their imagination and inventiveness through writing stories inspired by the texts like Great Expectations, Gangsta Granny and How to Train Your Dragon.

How you can support your child's learning

- Listen to your child read every day and ask them questions, for example, What do you think will happen next? How did the character feel when...?
- Continue to visit a library and borrow books for free.
- Ask your child to write stories, newspaper articles and information texts about the topics that they are learning and then encourage them to edit and improve these.

Year 4 children will sit a Times Tables test in June. Your child needs to know all their times tables up to 12x12.

How you can support your child's learning in Maths

The children will be learning how to use decimals and various methods of measurement, including time and money.

How you can support your child's learning

- Test your child on their times tables.
- Prepare a meal together and get your child counting, measuring, estimating and comparing amounts.
- Get your child to make amounts of money such as 83p using 8 x 10ps and 3 x 1ps.
- Allow your child to add the prices together and find the change.

How you can support your child's learning in Science

In Science, the children will be learning about the following topics:

- Sounds
- Animals Including Humans

How you can support your child's learning

- Carry out research to find out how sound is made.
- Explore how sounds can be made louder and quieter.
- Talk about how to look after your teeth and discuss why they are important for humans and animals.

How you can support your child's learning:

Summer 1- Streets of London

- Talk about the local area and how local buildings are used and how land has been used, e.g. shopping, leisure, government buildings, housing.
- Use Google Maps to look at important streets and landmarks in London. Discuss how and why the landmarks were built. Why are they important in London today?
- RE - Discuss what makes them the person that they are
- In RSHE we will look at how we are growing and changing, puberty and explore strategies to help us be more assertive when in a difficult situation.

Summer 2 - Ancient Greece

- Visit the library and carry out research on Ancient Greece
- Discuss how life today is similar / different to life in Ancient Greece
- RE - Discuss how marriage takes place in different religions and what ceremonies they have.
