How you can help at home

- Listen to your child read daily. Children are able to exchange their reading books every Tuesday.
- Encourage your child to write regularly, whether it's journaling about their day, writing stories, or even composing emails or letters to friends or family members.

Maths

- Problem solving and efficient methods

How you can help at home

- Use the number fluency book with your child.
- Ask them to 'teach' you how to solve the problems in their homework books as this helps them consolidate the learning in their long term memory
- Encourage your children to use the TTRockstars and Maths Prodigy websites.
- Ask your child to tell you about their learning.

Science

- Evolution and inheritance
- Planning and carrying out investigations

How you can help at home

- Discuss your family with your child. What traits of yours have they inherited?
- Ask your child what they are doing in science.
- Use documentaries or books
- Nature documentaries (e.g. those featuring David Attenborough) are excellent for showing evolution in real life

Computing

How you can help at home

- Ask your child how they can assess the validity of websites or online resources.
- Speak to your child about their use of technology and social media such as TikTok.
- Have a system, as a parent, so that you are aware of what your child is doing online. This may take the form of a filtering or monitoring system.

Ranelagh Curriculum

Our Ranelagh topic in the first part of the term will be Tourism - a study of its impacts around the globe. You could support this learning by discussing your child's dream holiday, why they would like to visit that place and how they think tourism is affecting our local area.

In the latter part of the term, we will learn about the history of film and film-making. The children will have opportunities to create their own films. This will coincide with our end of year production which will be a live action musical with some elements of video and sound effects.

In PE, children will be playing Kickball rounders, building gymnastic routines, performing short dance sequences and completing athletic challenges. There will be weekly guitar lessons for all children. Be sure to ask children what song they have been learning.
