"I want to be a firefighter! I can save everyone" said Emma.



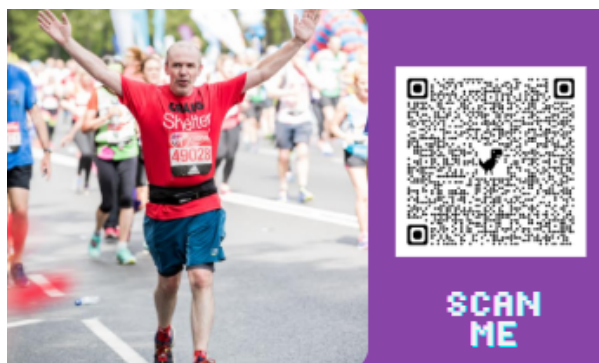
Music Quizathon
