## Year 5 Swaps the Classroom for the Riverbank

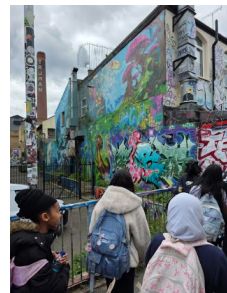
