Where	Double Gates into Key Stage 2 playground on Napier Road will be signed Year 6	

- Please stay 2 metres apart from other children and parents.
- **Children must be accompanied by an adult.**
- Only 1 parent may bring their child to school.
- No parents will be allowed onto the school premises.
- If you have any questions or queries, please phone or email the school
- **Parents must stick to the specific school times, drop off and pick up points.**
- Gates will only be open for the allotted time, if your child is late they will not be allowed into the school building therefore your child needs to be accompanied by a parent.
- There will be no more than 15 children per class, this means that your child may not have their usual teacher.
- The children will be divided up into groups - these will not be changed.
- **The children will not bring in anything from home** -this includes **mobile phones**, school bags, PE kit and packed lunches. Lunch will be provided for them. Your child can bring in a water bottle.
- **Medication** - please ensure your child has their asthma pump.
- **Travel** -You need to follow the advice from the government, where possible walk to school and avoid public transport.
- Bikes and scooters will not be allowed.
- Your child will need to wear clean clothes each day - it does not have to be school uniform. As we will be spending time outside, please make sure your child is wearing suitable clothing/sunscreen.
- Your contact details are up to date. We will need to check this before your child attends school.
- You will need to provide us with notice to say that your child will be attending.

- If your child is ill, you will need to pick them up immediately.
- **Your child will not be allowed into school if they, or a member of the household, are showing symptoms of Covid 19.**
